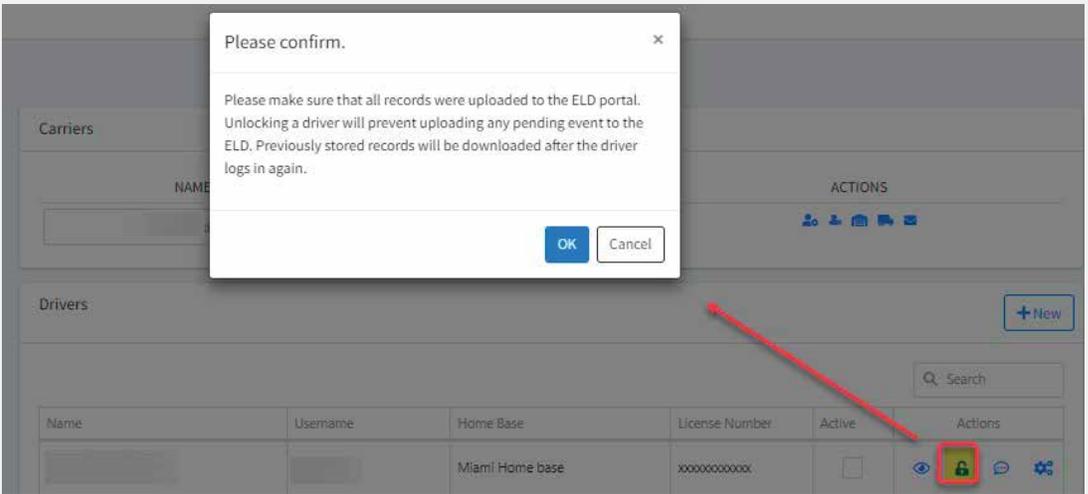
- Oil Well Service Vehicle Cycle Exemption Permit Added (Canada)

220-1		I	<p>3 – DVIR signatures</p> <p>1. From this version on, the DVIR reports can include up to three signatures. For example, drivers, mechanics, and others can now stamp their signatures if required.. Any time a DVIR has a defect selected, the three signatures will be required to allow the driver to start a new DVIR report.</p>  
220-2		I	 <p>16-Hour Exception (Section 395.1(o)).</p> <p>1. Per Section 395.1(o), property-carrying drivers may take a 16-hour duty period (instead of 14 hours) if, during the last five duty periods the driver worked, the driver returned to the normal work reporting location and did not exceed 14 hours. This would allow a driver to use this exception once every seven days. However, the last subparagraph in 395.1(o) allows the 16-hour exception to be used again as soon as the driver has had 34 or more consecutive hours off duty as allowed by Section 395.3(c) of the FMCSRs.</p> <p>2. Once the driver chooses the Asphalt, Concrete (Short-haul) ruleset in the Driver Profile, a new button is added to the main screen at the bottom left, allowing him use the SHORT HAUL EXEMPTION.</p>

220-3	 	/	<p>Alberta Ruleset.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Except as permitted by this Regulation, a carrier shall not permit a driver during the driver’s work shift: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) to exceed 13 hours of driving time, or (b) to drive at any time after the driver has been on duty for 15 or more consecutive hours. 2. A driver may, in the case of unexpected adverse driving conditions, exceed by not more than two additional hours the number of hours the driver is permitted to drive. 3. A driver may continuously drive a vehicle <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) for a period of time of up to 4 consecutive hours if at the conclusion of driving for that period of time the driver takes at least ten consecutive minutes off duty or of non-driving time, or (b) for a period of time that exceeds that permitted under clause (a) but does not exceed six consecutive hours if, at the conclusion of driving for that period of time, the driver takes at least 30 consecutive minutes off duty or of non-driving time.
