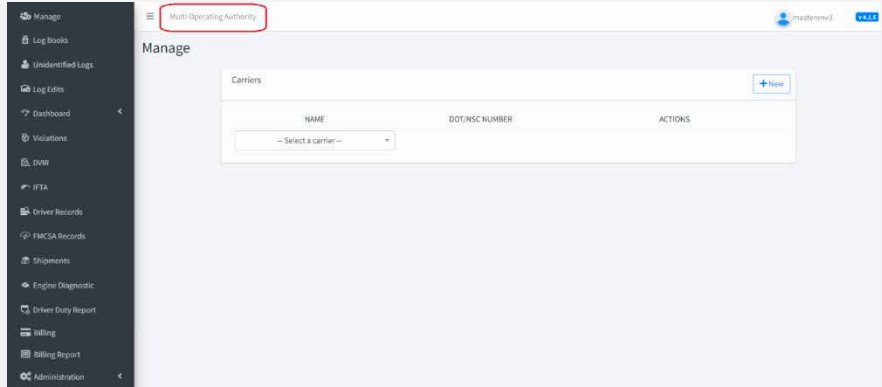








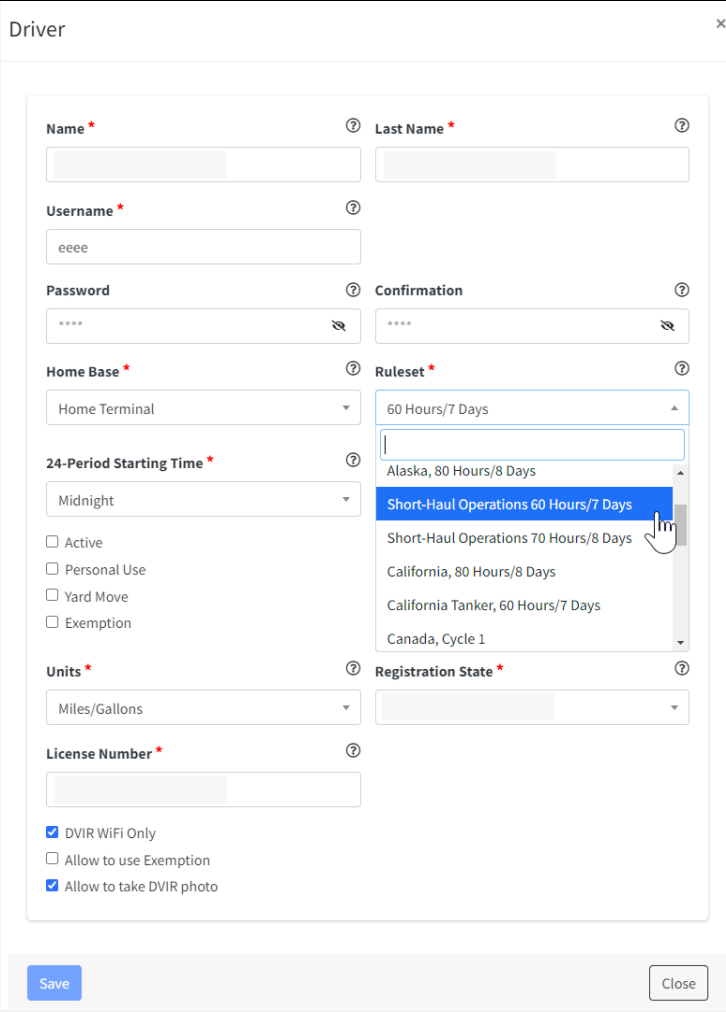

224-1	 	I	<p>Multi Operating Authority (MOA)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> We introduced a new hierarchy structure in our system where Carriers, Drivers, Home Bases and Assets belong to a MOA account. In that structure, a MOA account can manage multiple Carriers, Drivers, Home Bases and Assets. For example, a driver account assigned to an MOA account, can operate under any Carrier belonging to that MOA account and choose any assets as well under that MOA account. See attached document. 
224-2		I	<p>Any non-certified log can be certified, regardless of whether it is within cycle days or not.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> We added the possibility that any log, present on the app (tablet) database, can be certified no matter how old is that status.
224-3		I	<p>Canada Output file encryption added.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> From this version on we included, the encryption certified to comply with the Canadian Mandate related to the export output file to the Canadian transportation authority.
224-4	 	I	<p>Improvement VIN management.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> When the VIN number is being read from the vehicle ECM we will consider a valid value and we won't apply any local validation.
224-5	 	I	<p>Name change to Asphalt ruleset (Short-Haul Operation)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> As you can see in the image below, the Asphalt rules has now a more generic name: Short haul operation for 60 and 70 weekly on duty hours.
